



Dr Terrance Michael Drew was born in Upper Monkey Hill in St. Peter's to Gerzel "Ras Pet" Mills and Michael Heyliger. He was raised by his grandmother Helena Mills Saunders better known as Barber, but was also raised by his extended family.

He was christened at the Antioch Baptist Church by Dr William Connor and attended several Sunday schools; including Jericho in Upper Monkey Hill taught by Mr and Mrs Morton, a staunch Christian family.

Dr Drew completed his primary education at the St Peter's Primary School, now Deane-Glasford Primary School. He went on to the Basseterre Junior High School then the Basseterre High School. Upon successful completion of high school, he went on to the Sixth Form College, now Clarence Fitzroy Bryant College, where he successfully completed his studies in Science.



Dr Drew then became a teacher of mathematics and physics at his alma mater for two years. After this stint, he journeyed to Cuba on a medical scholarship, where he graduated as a medical doctor with First Class Honours.

Dr Drew returned home to St. Kitts and Nevis and worked as a medical doctor. During this time, he became a father to his only child Terrance Junior.

Dr Drew was determined to pursue specialist studies in the USA. He successfully completed the United States Medical Licensing Examination® and was accepted by Dr Macallum to pursue studies in internal medicine. He successfully completed these studies and is now a diplomate of the American Board of Internal Medicine.

Dr Drew joined the St. Kitts-Nevis Labour Party as a candidate in 2013, during the very difficult period of a Party that was divided as senior members had left. His only position and focus were to help his Party and Country.

Dr Drew's political influence came from his grandmother who was a staunch Labour Woman. He could recall her disappointments during the 1980s when Labour lost several elections. This left a significant impression on him.

Dr Drew also practices as a private doctor and serves the community, especially the elderly, through home visits. He reported that what drove his desire to help and serve others, was seeing an old lady who had to be carried away from her home, across a running ghaat during a storm, as there was no road for the ambulance to pass. He was determined that people should not live like that.

He is the founder of the C.A.R.E. Foundation (Compassionate Action to Reach and Empower), a foundation that was formed during the pandemic to serve those who were affected significantly. The C.A.R.E. Foundation has delivered hundreds of food packages, Chromebooks (laptops) to students and monetary assistance for persons who needed medical care.

Dr Drew has lived a diverse life. He was the president of the St Peter's Football Club, the St Peter's Basketball Club, and an executive member of the Eagle Boys Club. He has also served as medical doctor for the St. Kitts and Nevis National Football Team, the 'Sugar Boyz', as well as various local sports clubs. Dr Drew has his own scholarship programme and continues to sponsor football and basketball leagues. He has also personally taught extra classes in the Conaree community.

In his spare time, Dr Drew enjoys reggae music, going to the gym and watching Sci-Fi movies.
